7.3.1 - Highlight the performance of the institution in an area distinct to its priority and thrust (within a maximum of 200 words)

The academic year 2021 – 2022 was partly held in online mode during lockdown and partial offline mode began from February 2022. College conducted online teaching and examinations in the first half of an academic year whereas hybrid of online and offline teaching and examination in second half. This was carried out with an objective of making the teaching and learning smooth, enjoyable and acceptable to learners. Keeping the mission of the institution in mind, online and offline sessions, webinars, competitions and events were held throughout the academic year for the overall development of learners. In view of implementation of autonomy, various departments were engaged in designing of new curricula for 1st year UG and PG programmes to impart enriched academic experience to learners. To upgrade infrastructure of science departments and to give an enriching experience to students college submitted a proposal to Department of Biotechnology, Government of India under STAR Strengthening schemes. Learners were encouraged and mentored to participate in research proposal presentation competition organised by University of Mumbai. The outcome of this activity was an UG group acquiring 2nd place of merit and a PG group acquiring consolation prize for their proposal presentation.
